IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON THE INDIAN ECONOMY



ELECTIONS IN US





The relationship with the United States of America matters to India more than any other bilateral engagement: economically, strategically and socially. American Presidents can often make a real difference to bilateral ties, including on trade, on immigration policies, and larger strategic issues.

Outside the fringes, the mainstream of political opinion favours stronger relations between the two countries. Anti-Americanism, once the knee-jerk reaction of the Indian elite, seems almost antediluvian today. The Indian diaspora in the US is one of the most successful expatriate communities, and while their political preferences may differ — they all favour a closer bonding between their janmabhoomi or pitrabhoomi and their karmabhoomi.





How elections are conducted In USA?

Congress designated the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November as Election Day back in 1845.

In other U.S. elections, candidates are elected directly by popular vote. But the president and vice president are not elected directly by citizens. Instead, they're chosen by "electors" through a process called the Electoral College

The process of using electors comes from the Constitution. It was a compromise between a popular vote by citizens and a vote in Congress. Before the general election, most candidates for president go through a series of state primaries and caucuses. Though primaries and caucuses are run differently, they both serve the same purpose. They let the states choose the major political parties'

nominees for the general election.



The president must:

- Be a natural-born citizen of the United States
- · Be at least 35 years old
- Have been a resident of the United States for 14 years
- Anyone who meets these requirements can declare their candidacy for president. Once a candidate raises or spends more than \$5,000 for their campaign, they must register with the Federal Election Commission. That includes naming a principal campaign committee to raise and spend campaign funds.
