JIIT was granted Deemed to be University status under Section 3 of UGC Act 1956 in 2004. JIIT is an AICTE approved institution since 2018; accredited by NAAC with A grade in 2023. JIIT established a Digital Learning Centre that comprises of state-of-the-art multimedia studio, discussion and chroma studios, a 100-seater review cum lecture room supported by automated control, editing, and simulation and animation infrastructure.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

**JAYPEE BUSINESS SCHOOL a constituent of JAYPEE INSTITUTE OF
INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY(Deemed to be University), NOIDA**

AND

Holy Family Hospital,

Article 2 Arrangements

Internship (8 weeks) for MBA students of JBS (JIIT) having specialization in Hospital and Healthcare Management will be arrangement by Holy Family Hospital for the number of students, as agreed by them.

For other areas of cooperation as at Sr No, 2 to 6 of Article 1, arrangement including the financial implications will be in accordance with the formal agreement to be entered into for each area of cooperation. The formal agreement so entered into will be part of the MOU.

ARTICLE 3 CONFIDENTIALITY

Each party shall ensure to observe the confidentiality of documents, information and other data received from or supplied to, the other party during the period of the implementation of this MOU or any other agreements made pursuant to this MOU.

ARTICLE 4 MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

JBS (JIIT) and Holy Family Hospital will appoint representatives to manage and oversee the joint areas of cooperation. The representatives of the JBS (JIIT) and Holy Family hospital may meet as and when necessary to review progress in the implementation of the agreed arrangements, define new areas for agreement and programmes of cooperation as well as to discuss matters related to the MOU.

ARTICLE 5 AMENDMENTS

This MOU may only be amended by mutual agreement evidenced in writing by a duly authorised representative from JBS (JIIT) and Holy Family Hospital.

ARTICLE 6 TERM OF AGREEMENT

This MOU shall commence on the date of its execution by the last to sign of JBS (JIIT) and Holy Family Hospital and shall remain in force for a period of five years and may be renewed upon its expiry and with the agreement of both parties.

Either JBS (JIIT) and Holy Family Hospital may cancel the MOU by giving six months' notice in writing to the other. Activities in progress at the time of termination of this MOU shall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed.
